Listed below are the end of year expectations for children in Reception Class. Whilst they do not cover all of the Early Learning Goals, we have identified these objectives as the <u>minimum</u> requirement needed for your child to meet to ensure they are ready to make progress for the following year.

These objectives will be taught throughout the year but any extra support you can provide for your child will be of great value to help them achieve. If you have any queries regarding this or want support in knowing how best to help your child please talk to your child's teacher.

Mathematics

- Count reliably to 20.
- Order numbers 1 20.

- Say 1 more/1 less to 20.
- Add and subtract two single-digit numbers.

Reading

- Read some common irregular words.
- Identify rhymes and alliteration.
- Join in with rhyming patterns.
- Read and understand simple sentences.
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.
- Make basic predictions.

Writing

- Write simple sentences which an be read by themselves and others.
- Write name (correct upper and lower case).
- Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.
- Write clearly demarcated sentences.
- Correct pencil grip.
- Correct letter formation for familiar words.
