Industrial Action by Teachers

Dear Parent/Carer.

I hope that this letter finds you well and that you all have had a lovely half term break.

Further to my previous correspondence re: Industrial Action by Teachers I am writing out with an update around school opening this **Wednesday (01.03.2023)**

As you are no doubt aware this Industrial Action is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over a lack of funding in education, teachers' pay and the recruitment and retention crisis in teaching and not because of any issues at our school. This is a national strike.

Teachers are under no obligation to inform me of their decision, however, I am able to let you know that this Wednesday Saint Mary's will be partially open. **Children in Year 6 are required to attend school as normal.**

Please note that there will be no extra-curricular clubs running on that day.

Going forward this month, we will continue to treat each potential Industrial Action occurrence on a day-to-day basis and I will write out with information accordingly.

If your child/ren is entitled to free school meals (FSM), a packed lunch will be provided which can be picked up from school. If you are entitled and you would like a packed lunch, please contact the school office in person, by telephone or email by Tuesday 28th February 2pm to allow the catering team to prepare accordingly.

The packed lunch will include a sandwich (cheese or tuna), fruit, flapjack and a drink. Please collect packed lunches from the school office on Wednesday Ist March 2023 between 10:30am – 12:00pm.

Breakfast club and SMASH will operate as normal only for those pupils attending school that day. Please book and confirm with wrap-around care staff to help with provision planning.
