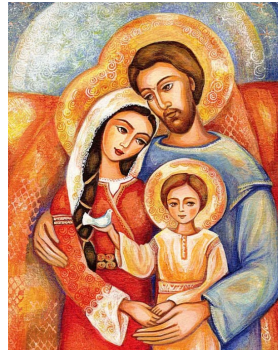
## Topic: Families - Year One - Domestic Church

### The Psalms

- A **Psalm** is a prayer and a song.
- In the Bible, the Book of **Psalms** has 150 prayer songs.
- Psalm 28 thanks **God** for taking **care** of us.
- Psalm 63 reminds us that **God** loves everything he has created
- Psalm 16 tells us of **God's** love and care.
