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#### Science


## **Animals including Humans**


This half term we will be focussing on the question,

# 'Why is the heart the most important pump that we own?'

During this topic, the children will:

- Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system.
- Know the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.
- Know the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.
- Know the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

In our Guided Reading sessions we will be looking at our Focus text, Pig Heart Boy, and using the different reading techniques to explore the book in detail.
