English

This half term, Derwent class is embarking on an exciting adventure into the enchanting world of Greek mythology. We are learning how to create our own Greek myths, where imagination and creativity take centre stage. As we delve into the tales of gods, heroes, and mythical creatures, we will focus on developing rich character and setting descriptions that capture the essence of ancient Greece.

In our lessons, we will examine well-known myths such as the story of Medusa and her dreaded curse, as well as the adventures of Hercules. Through these stories, we will explore how authors bring characters to life with descriptive language.

By the end of the half term, each student will have crafted their own original Greek myth, filled with imaginative characters and captivating settings.



<u>Music</u>

This half term, our music lessons focus on the exciting world of musical theatre. We will look into the history of musicals, and the details and

story's behind certain songs.

Our lessons will end in groups of children creating their own musical scene.



Maths

Our focus in maths is diving deeper into the world of decimals. We will revisit the decimal skills we have gained so far and enhance our understanding by applying these concepts to real-life situations, particularly focusing on money. We will explore how decimals play a vital role in everyday transactions, such as when we buy items in shops or manage our pocket money.

During our lessons, we will begin with a refresher on decimal place value, ensuring everyone is confident in identifying tenths, hundredths, and even thousandths. Through interactive activities, we will practise adding and subtracting decimals, immersing ourselves in challenges that require us to handle real currency. For instance, we will simulate shopping scenarios where we calculate totals and work out change, providing us with a practical context for our skills.

As we approach the end of this half term, we will dedicate a week to exploring the measurement of time. We will learn to convert between different time units and apply our knowledge by scheduling events and activities. Understanding time is crucial, just like working with decimals, as it helps us organise our daily lives efficiently.

Design & Technology

We will discuss their functions, aesthetics, potential users, materials used, as well as weighing up the pros and cons of different designs. A key emphasis will be on sustainability, encouraging our children to consider the environmental impact of the products we commonly use.
